LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Today, June 6th, marks the 80th anniversary of D-Day, also known as Operation Overlord. This was the beginning of a bloody 77-day battle and the start of the Allied liberation of France during World War II. Canadian soldiers were tasked with taking Juno Beach, one of five beaches on the Normandy coast. As there are very few veterans who are still alive who fought at this battle, it is especially important to acknowledge and remember the sacrifices made for our freedom.
