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Opening Day Schedule:

Tuesday September 5th is our first day of school and students will be arriving for homeroom for attendance, to pick up schedules, school information and receive a safety orientation to the upcoming school year. Below is our Opening Day Schedule:

School Bell Schedule (Grade 8/9 Linear & Grade 10 – 12 Semester)

Delta Secondary will be implementing a hybrid schedule for the 2023 – 2024 school year.

- Grade 8 and 9 students will be on a linear schedule (8 courses from September to June) with a Day 1/Day 2 schedule.
- Grade 10 12 students will be on a semester schedule where they will take 4 classes for semester 1 (September January) and 4 classes for semester 2 (February June).
- New this year, we will be running a week 1 (A, B, C, D) and week 2 (B, A, D, C) schedule alternating weeks (see sample schedule below)
 - For our Grade 8's and 9's they will alternate between their Day 1 classes (A1, B1, C1, D1) and Day 2 classes (A2, B2, C2, D2).
- We will continue to run a 35-minute FLEX Block between Period 1 & 2 and a 40-minute lunch break between periods 2 and 3.
 - FLEX Time is 35 minutes of instructional time built between period 1 & 2 to support students in the following ways:
 - Receive additional support and assistance from their teacher
 - Complete assignments or tasks pending due to absence
 - Additional practice and review to build fundamental skills
 - Independent Study and review for upcoming assessments
 - Passion Projects and Inquiry in one of their areas of study
 - Students will be required to sign up in advance for FLEX Time with one of their teachers. More information will be shared with students at their grade assembly.
- Every Wednesday, classes will start at 9:30am to support teacher Collaboration.

 Wednesday classes will be 65 minutes in length with a 40-minute lunch break between period 2 and 3. There is NO FLEX Block on Wednesdays

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Student Schedules:

Student MyED accounts will be reactivated by the district on Friday September 2nd and students will then be able to view their schedule. Communications with Families:

Most of our communication will be done electronically through our website, monthly newsletters, emails and Parent Connect. Please ensure you have provided us a current email address, updated all your contact information and are able to log into Parent Connect. Please contact the office if you require assistance.

It is mandatory that all forms be reviewed and responded by each student's parent/guardian by September 30th.

Student Fees:

Student Fees will be assessed during Semester 1 once class changes have been made. Fees can be viewed on Student/Parent Connect. Fees include a basic student fee, an Emergency Preparedness fee and in some cases, students may be assessed a course fee to cover the cost of consumable materials. Students may also choose to purchase optional 'enhancements' that support a course but are not required for course completion. Yearbook fees will be assessed to all students. We are encouraging parents to pay fees online using Parent Connect.

No Cell Phone During Instructional Time Policy: (New for 2023 – 2024)

In order to support student learning and teachers with navigating the issues and challenges that come with cell phones as distractions in classes when not used for educational purposes, Delta Secondary is implementing a "No Cell Phone Policy" during instructional time which includes Flex Time.

• Cell phone use in class without prior teacher consent is NOT PERMITTED. It is up to teachers' discretion as to when devices can be used and for what purposes. Students have the option to secure their phone in their personal bag, classroom phone blanket or designated area determined by the teacher. Students may also secure their phones in their lockers or leave them at home.

Extracurricular Activities:

We are expecting a return to extra-curricular activities for the 2023 – 2024 school year. Mr. Andrew Robson and Mrs. Kayla Jow are our school's Athletic Directors and they will be providing information to students and our community regarding school athletic opportunities. Student participation in these activities is an important part of a student's school experience. Participation in these activities are a privilege and students participating are expected to be in good standing as they represent our school community on the playing field and in various extracurricular events. PAC (Parent Advisory Council):

This year's PAC Chair is Mrs. Alison Day. PAC typically does not organize fundraising events and Delta Secondary's PAC meetings take place in the evening, approximately once per month (3rd Wednesday of the month in our learning commons).

School PAC's provide feedback and input to the school administration and play an integral role in supporting extracurricular programs and student lead legacy projects and initiatives.

Ways to help set your child(ren) up for success in the school year:

- Set high expectations for your child(ren) and encourage them to not accept minimum effort or indifference to quality work;
- Contact teachers directly when you have a question regarding your child(ren)'s progress;
- Ensure good attendance (attendance can be viewed on Parent Connect);
- Provide a quiet place in your home for study with few distractions;
- Insist that your child(ren) accept responsibility for their learning and their conduct;
- Model the importance of life-long learning and inquiry;
- Encourage a strong work ethic and promote good time management skills;
- Encourage regular review and application of learning to develop foundational skills;
- Encourage your child(ren) to maintain healthy eating (breakfast, lunch, and healthy snacks) and sleeping habits (8+ hours of sleep minimum)

Communicable Disease Plan:

To continue to ensure we are collectively doing our part to keep our school community safe from communicable disease we are going to ask that students and families continue to do the following this year:

- Complete a Daily Health Check and stay home when your child is sick
 - Do NOT come to school if you are ill, have symptoms or not able to participate fully in routine activities
- Respiratory etiquette and respect the personal space of others
- Good hand hygiene wash and sanitize your hands often
- Remember to "Be kind, be calm, be safe" to others.

We are excited for the upcoming school year and looking forward to welcoming back all of our returning students as well as making connections with our new students.
