#### Flexible Learning Time:

Monday September 25<sup>th</sup> will be our last prescribed Flex Time (where the school dictates where the students go). Over the past two weeks, teachers have been teaching lessons on goal setting, executive functioning and helping students navigate their student connect accounts to sign-up for Flex Blocks.

Moving forward, students will have the ability to sign-up for Flex Time with one of their current teachers. Students are required to sign-up for Flex Time in advance and we ask that parents work with their child to determine what flex blocks they should attend to meet their learning needs.

- Receive additional help from their teacher(s)
- Catch up on missed work due to absence/illness
- Review and study for upcoming assessments
- Practice or review to build foundational skills
