Flexible Learning Time:

Starting Monday September 12th, we will be implementing **Flexible Learning Time** or “FLEX Block” as it is referred to by students. **Flex Block is a 35-minute block of instructional time** built into our schedule between period 1 and period 2 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. **Students are required to be in a Flexible Learning Block.**

Reasons for Flexible Learning:

- Complete assignments and reduce homework
- Receive additional help from their teacher(s)
- Catch up on missed work due to absence/illness
- Review and study for upcoming assessments
- Practice or review to build foundational skills
- Extend the learning and inquiry in a particular subject

We will be prescribing Flex Time for the month of September in order to assist students in learning how to sign-up for their Flex Block using Student Connect. As we transition into Flex Blocks, we will also be providing mini-lessons around goal setting, time management, and effective strategies to maximize the use of Flexible Learning Time to support students.

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For the remainder of September (September 12 – 30), students will be directed to the following Flex Blocks:

- Monday's – Block A Flex
- Tuesday's – Block B Flex
- Thursday's – Block C Flex
- Friday's – Block D Flex
 - *****No Flex Block on Wednesdays**

Grade 12's – CLC & Capstone

Grade 12 students will be invited to enroll in a google classroom later next week to begin their Career Life Connection 12 Course and Capstone Project. Study Blocks:

The expectation is that students will be enrolled with a full-time schedule (8 courses). **An in-school study block is a privilege and reserved for grade 11 & 12 students who have ample credits, a challenging academic course load, and a history of good attendance and academic success.**

Delta Secondary offers a rich variety of courses and believes that students should take advantage of the opportunity for a full and comprehensive educational experience. We encourage students to explore and try courses that they may have limited knowledge or experience in as a means of exploration, inquiry and possible opportunities for future study, career or personal pursuit. Students may meet with their counsellors next week to pick up a study block application form and inquire about if they meet the criteria for a study block. Study blocks will be reviewed by Mr. Pavão and decided on by the end of September. **NOT all students who apply receive a study block and therefore students need to continue to attend all their classes.**
