


## Course Selection on MyEducationBC

1. Go to MYED BC Website at: <https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>
2. Enter your Log-in ID (Student # on Student ID Card) and Password



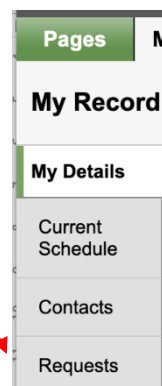

3. If you are using a mobile device (phone, tablet, etc.) you should choose to view the full site

4. On the home page 'click' on My Info

### Attention: Grade 11's of 2020-2021

- Please choose your courses carefully. The timetable is built based on your choices now. In the fall, there may not be space to allow you to change your mind, and inadequate demand now could result in a course you want being cancelled if you don't indicate your desire to take it now.
- Students entering grade 11 next year will be required to choose an option for the following required course areas:
  - An English 11
  - A Social Studies 11 or 12 option
  - A Mathematics 11
  - At least one Science 11
- Students must also choose 4 Elective courses and 2 - 4 alternates. Choose your electives in order of preference with your #1 choice the first course selected etc.
- Outside the Timetable Electives
