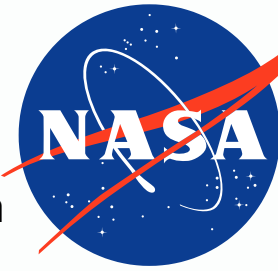

Important - Limited access to deltalearns email and account - Graduating Students

Hello Grade 12 deltalearns.ca Google WorkSpace Account user,

As you may, or may not be aware, deltalearns Google accounts issued by the Delta School district remain active only for the duration during which students are enrolled within the Delta School District.

Once a student leaves the Delta School District for any reason, including transferring to another district, or graduation, the student's deltalearns Google account is suspended six weeks following the last day of enrollment. At the conclusion of the six weeks, users will no longer have access to their deltalearns.ca Google account, including Google Drive and Gmail.

We are informing you of this now, as you may be using your @deltalearns.ca G-mail address to correspond with post secondary institutions, applications for scholarships, employers, on-line accounts or others. We strongly recommend that an alternate email address be used for correspondence that will extend beyond graduation, or withdrawal from the district, so as to avoid any interruption in communication.

Users will also lose access to files in their Drive. These [instructions](#) can be used to transfer files from your deltalearns Google My Drive to a personal Google account. We recommend you begin this process in Mid June.

GET UP TO \$10,000 FOR HIRING A NEW FIRST-YEAR APPRENTICE!

The Program

Canadian employers can receive up to **\$10,000** through CASP when they hire a first-year apprentice in an eligible construction and/or manufacturing Red Seal trade.

Employers can also receive assistance with recruiting, onboarding, and retaining apprentices by accessing resources and training through CASP, including training on creating inclusive workplaces.

Available Funding

\$5,000 is available for qualifying employers who hire a new first-year apprentice in an eligible trade.

An additional **\$5,000** is available if the apprentice self-identifies as being from at least one of the following groups:

- Women
- Indigenous people
- Newcomers to Canada
- Persons with disabilities
- Visible minorities
- LGBTQ2+ individuals

Employers are eligible for funding for up to two new first-year apprentices per fiscal year (April 1–March 31).

How to Qualify

The employer must have fewer than 500 paid employees per CRA business number.

If a company has multiple divisions with multiple business numbers, each division with fewer than 500 employees may qualify.

The employer must sign a CASP agreement before registering the apprentice.

The apprentice must be a first-year apprentice enrolled in one of the eligible 39 Red Seal trades.

Skilled Trades Shortage

Over **700,000** skilled tradespeople will retire by 2028



Canada is facing a gap of more than **60,000** apprentices by 2025, plus a shortage of **100,000** skilled tradespeople by 2026

\$\$\$
Skilled tradespeople can make \$80-100k per year

375,000 apprenticeship registrations are needed between 2021–2025



Only 8.7% of apprentices are immigrants, even though immigrants make up more than 20% of the population

Only 11% of new apprentices in 2019 were women



Demand for soft skills like communication and teamwork is rising in the trades

Less than 4% of workers in the most in-demand trades are women
