#### FAO

- 1) What is the approximate cost to play on a Pacer athletic team?

  Each team has their own budget that is divided between the amount of players the team has. A team budget considers the following:
  - BC School Sports Fee
  - South Fraser Athletic Association Fee
  - Delta Schools Athletic Association Fee
  - Delta Secondary School Athletic Fee
  - Transportation Fees (for coaches gas reimbursement)
  - Tournament Fees
  - Officiating Fees \*applies to specific sports\*
  - Facility Rental Fees \*applies to sports that use off-site facilities\*
  - Travel Expenses (example: a tournament that is out of town)
  - Teacher Teaching on Call cost If a teacher has to miss a day of school to coach
  - Coaches year end gift and clothing
  - South Fraser Championships
- 2) What are additional costs that could be added after?
  - Team Clothing (optional)
  - Qualifying for a Provincial Championships
- 3) Delta Secondary School Athletic Fee How much is it? What does it pay for?
  - \$30, Pacer Athletic T-Shirt, new team equipment, Athletic Banquet, first aid supplies, new uniforms, coach appreciation gift, general wear and tear of facilities equipment.
- 4) If my child makes multiple teams, do they have to pay the Delta Secondary School Athletic Fee for each team?
  - Yes, they do. It is very expensive to run an athletics program.
     Especially with the wear and tear on team uniforms, team equipment and facilities.

- 5) If my child quits a team, will I get a refund or do the fees still need to be paid?
  - Once a budget is set, the cost is then divided by the number of players. If a child quits, a refund will not be given, because of this.
- 6) When are my child's team fees due?

- Fall: October 15th

- Winter: January 15th

- Spring: April 25th

- 7) What if my child does **not** make a team?
  - There are opportunities to improve skills within community sports associations (example: South Delta Basketball Association, various club volleyball leagues, etc.)
- 8) What is our Pacer Athletics Philosophy?
  - Our student-athletes are students <u>first</u> and athletes <u>second</u>. Our student-athletes are <u>required</u> to attend regularly, participate to the best of their ability and conduct themselves in a respectful manner while contributing to the classroom learning environment.
- 9) What forms are required from athletes **prior** to league play?
  - All Pacer athletes are required to submit two completed forms.
    - 1) Player Code of Conduct online form that are signed by both the athlete and the parents/guardians
      - If any of the rules listed on the Player Code of Conduct are breached, a player may be removed from the team.
    - 2) **Teacher** forms that are signed by all of the athlete's current teachers
      - Please note this signature can be revoked at any time if there is an academic or behavioral concern which would make the player ineligible.
- 10) What age group does the fair play rule apply to?
  - The DSSAA rule only applies at the **grade 8** level except during playoffs. Fair play does not apply in playoffs.
- 11) Is my child guaranteed playing time in games?
  - No. The volunteer coach decides who they believe is the best fit to play during the event.
