Course Selection-2025/2026

Every year a general school fee is assessed as well as enhancement fees in a number of courses. As we begin second semester enhancement fees for semester 2 courses will be assessed by the second week of February. Once fees have been assessed an email will be sent to all families. Fees owed by your child according to the courses in which they are enrolled will be viewable on Parent Connect. Any unpaid fees from semester 1/linear courses are currently available online. Fees are payable online using Parent Connect or by cheque, cash, or card at the DSS office. If paying by cash or cheque at the office, please include your child's name and grade. Delta Secondary is committed to ensuring that no student is denied the opportunity to participate in a course, class or program because of financial hardship. DSS Athletics

January was another busy month for athletics as basketball teams were in full swing. The Delta league play for grade 8 and junior teams has now concluded and we can proudly say that all five of our teams finished top 3 in their respective divisions.

Our grade 8 girls basketball team has been the standout as of late. The girls finished their regular season going undefeated in league play, 6-0, capturing first place heading into playoffs.

The Junior boys' and girls' teams have also had a jam-packed tournament schedule, competing at various schools across the lower mainland. Our girls strongest finish came at the Khalsa tournament where they captured first place, and the boys at Enver Creek where they were also tournament champions.

Gr. 9 Immunizations

On Wednesday March 5th, the Fraser Health Nurses will be coming to Delta Secondary to provide immunizations to Grade 9 students.

In addition to immunizing grade 9 students, this year we will be offering immunizations to grade 8, 10, 11, and 12 students who had a letter mailed to their home. If you received a letter in the mail and would like your child to be immunized at school, please ensure they bring this letter with them to school on Wednesday, March 5th, 2025. If you did not receive a letter, your child does not need any additional immunizations at this time.

Grade 10 students with completed consent forms from 2024 that still have outstanding immunizations will be offered immunizations on Delta Secondary Immunization Day 2, April 30th, 2025.

Fraser Health Info.- BC's HPV Immunization Catch-Up Campaign

Important changes to Fraser Health's in-school immunizations program for the remainder of the 2024/25 school year.

• Starting in January 2025, Fraser Health is expanding HPV vaccinations to all eligible students in Gr. 6-12, in all public and independent schools, as part of the provincial campaign to increase HPV immunizations

•Human Papillomavirus (HPV) immunizations protect against several cancers later in life and works best when given during adolescence

•Fraser Health is aiming for 90 percent HPV immunization coverage for 17 year olds by 2026.

•Eligible students will receive a letter advising them of the opportunity to get immunized at their school's scheduled immunization clinic.

International Program- Looking For Homestay Families

Hello Delta School District families,

Delta School District International Programs is currently recruiting homestay families for international students coming to Delta School District for February 2025, summer 2025, and September 2025. They will arrive from all over the world and have a strong desire to be in Delta.

The reimbursement for hosting is \$1,150 per month. Multiple students from different nationalities can be hosted in one home. The majority of students in the homestay program are from Germany, Japan, Spain, Italy, and Brazil. At the moment, more than 20 different countries are represented in the homestay program.

Many are looking for a family connection and being a part of a family during their stay in Delta. Their study periods range from 3 months to



half a school year, to a full school year, to multiple years. There are also short-term summer programs where host parents welcome younger English learners into their home. It is a great way for students to see what school (and life) in Delta is like and for new homestay families to get a small sample of what hosting is like.
