

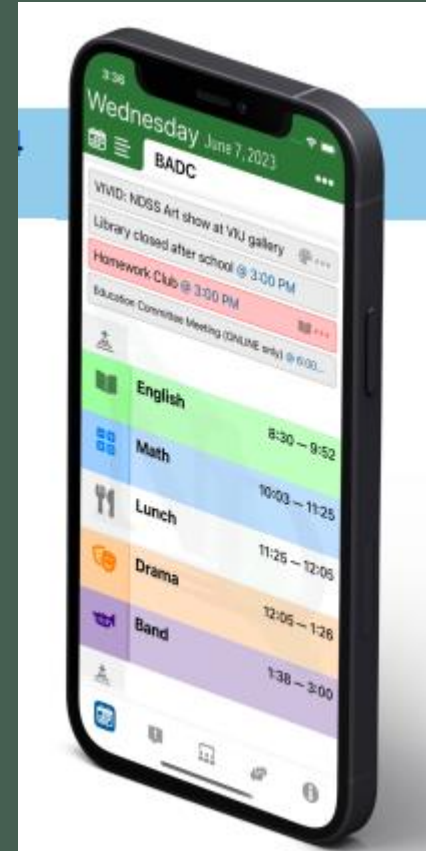

FLEX BLOCK

- FLEX – Monday / Tuesday / Thursday / Friday
- Students register in advance on Student Connect
- Flex block is the first level of support for students
 - Concept clarification,
 - catch up on homework, or
 - study for upcoming assessments.



LEARNING SUPPORT

- Targeted for support in academic courses
- Learning support teachers collaborate with classroom teachers to make learning accessible for students
- Students with ministry designations can qualify
- Students presenting with learning challenges will be assessed by school team.

COUNSELLING SERVICES

Students meet with counsellors to discuss:

- mental health concerns, social or emotional challenges, or academic concerns, questions & changes.

Students make an email appointment, unless they're in a crisis

Confidentiality - what students disclose to counsellors is confidential, unless:

- Student gives permission to discuss with others
- Harm is being done to the student
- Student shares thoughts about harming themselves or others
